The second meeting of the Kansas Numismatic Assc. was called to order by its president Alan Johnson. The minutes were read and approved and the treasurer's report was read and approved. The

The site for our convention next year will be Salina. Tentative dates were set at Early March or April 1984. Carl Adrain and Maury Peters have agreed to get things going for the convention. They will need the support of the local clubs and anyone else who is willing to help as there will be a lot to do. The charge for tables was set at \$125.

The convention for 1985 will be in Wichita and Dave Liljestrang will get things organized there. He hopes that several of the clubs will cooperate.
